



SANDUSKY COUNTY BUILDING DEPARTMENT

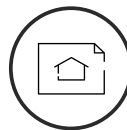
The Sandusky County Building Department is responsible for the administration and enforcement of the applicable State of Ohio Building Codes for commercial and industrial construction, alterations, and additions.

The Sandusky County Building Department currently has jurisdiction over all unincorporated areas in the County, along with the City of Fremont, Village of Gibsonburg, Village of Woodville, and the entire City of Bellevue. Additionally, the County Building Department is responsible for all plumbing approvals and inspections throughout all areas of the County except for the City of Bellevue.



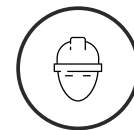
Registration

Contractors must obtain a registration before any work is performed. The following contractors must provide proof of licensure by the State of Ohio: Electrical, Fire Protection, HVAC, Plumbing, Hydronics, Refrigeration



Plan Review

Plans can be submitted in paper or electronic format. Typical plan review turnaround is 10-14 business days.



Inspections

Inspections are scheduled with a 24 hour notice. We will provide a 2 hour window for the inspector to arrive on site.
