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Commissioner Schwochow led the Pledge of Allegiance and then called session to order. Session began at 8:00am.

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Commissioners reviewed numerous mailings. Minutes from session 6/20/17 were reviewed and approved. Invoices were approved in electronic and paper fashion.

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Other items for other offices signed and/or reviewed by the Commissioners: A letter to Representative Reineke regarding the Ohio Dept. of Education. The monthly health insurance internal invoice.

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Acting Clerk discussion: A phone call was placed to Representative Reineke's office at 8:06 a.m. and a message was left concerning the budget NOT including language that would address the loss of the Medicaid MCO sales tax for counties and transit authorities. Courthouse security was discussed. A phone call was placed to Sheriff Hilton regarding employee entrances for Monday morning for a status report. A message was left at 8:11 a.m.

Commissioner Miller was at a TMACOG meeting yesterday. He stated there were quite a few people there. Biggest item discussed was water quality. Sandusky County was given kudos and they are glad we have come on board. An orientation for our engineers and health department was had after the meeting.

Commissioner Reiter attended FCFC executive finance committee. Shortfall on grant they applied for so they will have less money. Cathy Glassford will be coming in to ask for more money, about \$5,000.00. She also learned we have a Sandusky County Homeless Coalition Committee. A private entity has approached Promedica regarding building a homeless shelter that is not connected to the Homeless Coalition Committee.
