Health Department Certification went well yesterday. He stated we have a great Health Department in Sandusky County. They have many great programs for a County our size. They stay very competitive in reaching out for money that is available.

The T-Cap grant is out and our Adult Probation department has already filed for the grant. There is some extra money that he has for Sandusky County and he is looking to see what programs it would best assist.

Grant applications for this year are running about the same as last year. Many of these applications are asking for money for things that will always need assistance. Many depend on Medicaid funding and need additional to cover.

Talked about a detox center in Sandusky County. There has been talk about this and they wanted to know if there is a plan for this. There is a local investor that would like to open detox center in two Seneca County facilities and one here in Sandusky County. These would be inpatient and outpatient services.

Travel Request:

Travel request for County Administrator for CoRSA renewal meeting in Columbus was approved.

Public forum portion of session proceeded.

Citizen attendees: Residents of 18 Westwood area came in to talk about the increase in there water treatment rates. In 1976 there was an agreement made between the residents and the commissioners that rates would not be increased without a meeting. They have just received a notice of rate increases without a meeting. After talking with the sanitary engineers part of this is to upgrade the system by paving the road way back to the pump station, upgrade the station by adding a bathroom and getting Ohio Power out there to add additional power to keep the station running in the event of a power outage. The residents out there do not believe that some of these upgrades are necessary and they shouldn't have to pay for it. They do see the need to replace the facility but they feel it should be the exact same system.
