The Prosecutor sent the opinion and Carlos met with Wood County Engineer this week. Carlos was able to address all his concerns on the project. The plan is to move forward with the next step. They are starting bridge inspections for next year. He is finishing up 2026 budget and scheduling the 2026 bridge and road projects. The East State Street roundabout project will start most likely in April next year. Carlos sent an agreement/legislation that needs to be approved to close off the two roads involved in the project.
