Functions include performing intake/release procedures, observing/monitoring residents, preparing/serving meals, running a state-of-the-art electronic Control Room, overseeing family visitation, supervising various recreational activities, light cleaning & maintenance, miscellaneous clerical functions, facility laundry tasks, routine security checks, classroom monitoring, occasional community service supervision, and more.
