Duties:

Employee will be designated to develop, oversee, and implement the treatment foster care policies and program. Employee will Recruit, Approve, License and Monitor the treatment foster care program. This employee will coordinate service delivery for treatment caregivers and children in treatment care as the treatment team leader. Will be responsible for the case management of treatment-level children and treatment foster homes.

This position will be a fully remote, flexible schedule working in a multi-county area. This position may require non-traditional working hours, including evenings and weekends.

Qualifications:

Master's Degree in Social Work or related Master's Degree AND a minimum of 3 years of relevant paid experience within a social services setting *preferred*; OR Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or related Bachelor's Degree AND a minimum of 5 years of relevant paid experience within a social services setting. LISW, LSW, currently approved as an Assessor in the State of Ohio preferred, but not required.

Experience:

Prefer experience with behavioral needs and behavioral plans for children; Experience in a social services setting dealing with abuse and neglect; Experience in service coordination.

Equivalent combination of education, experience, and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

A valid driver's license with acceptable driving record is required. The candidate may have to drive personal vehicle and must maintain required liability limits.
