### Nature and Purpose of Work

The *Apiary Inspector* is responsible for assisting Sandusky County. The inspector is to inspect honey bee colonies for pests and diseases.

### Job Qualifications

- High School education (OR)
- Completion of secondary education
- Must have minimum three years beekeeping experience

### General

- Must have and maintain a valid Ohio driver's license, have and maintain automobile insurance and a good driving record. Must be able to operate motor vehicles during daylight and evenings hours, on both public and private roads.
- Must communicate effectively in English using both written and oral forms of communication.
- Must have the physical ability to maneuver rough and steep terrain on foot.
- Must be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Must be willing to work with and have exposure to beehives, bee colonies, and pests.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Responsible for planning and administering county-wide inspection and enforcement activity related to apiarian laws and regulations per Chapter 909 of the Ohio Revised Code
- Inspect all colonies of registered apiaries for proper booking practices, diseases, and pests
- Make recommendations and educates beekeepers on health of colony
- Provides technical information on treatment and control of health issues
- Complete inspection reports, monthly reports on inspections and findings

### Supervision and Guidance

The employee occupying this position is directly responsible to the Sandusky Board of Supervisors and under the direct supervision of the District Administrator. The employee

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will adhere to the Sandusky Soil and Water Conservation District personnel employment policy. The employee will carry out responsibilities as assigned by the Supervisors.
