Better efficiency, better safety, no cost

The Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) is designed to reduce heating costs and make homes safer, more comfortable and more energy efficient. The program is available to homeowners and renters living in Wood, Sandusky, Ottawa, Seneca, Erie and Huron counties.

HWAP clients receive an extensive inspection of their homes and professionally installed and tested energy-saving upgrades that may include:

- Insulated attics, walls, floors and water pipes
- Repaired or new furnaces
- Energy-efficient light bulbs
- Repaired or new water heaters
- Energy-saving water measures

To qualify, households must be at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines as detailed below. For households of more than eight persons, add \$8,320 for each additional household member.
